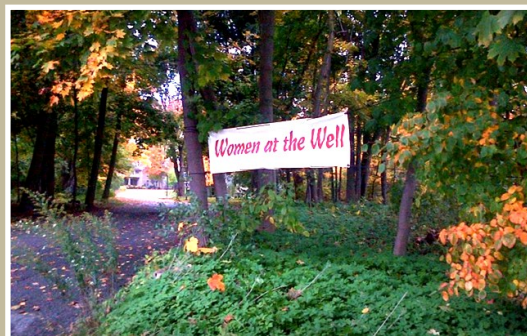

Woodycrest to GBCC driveway.

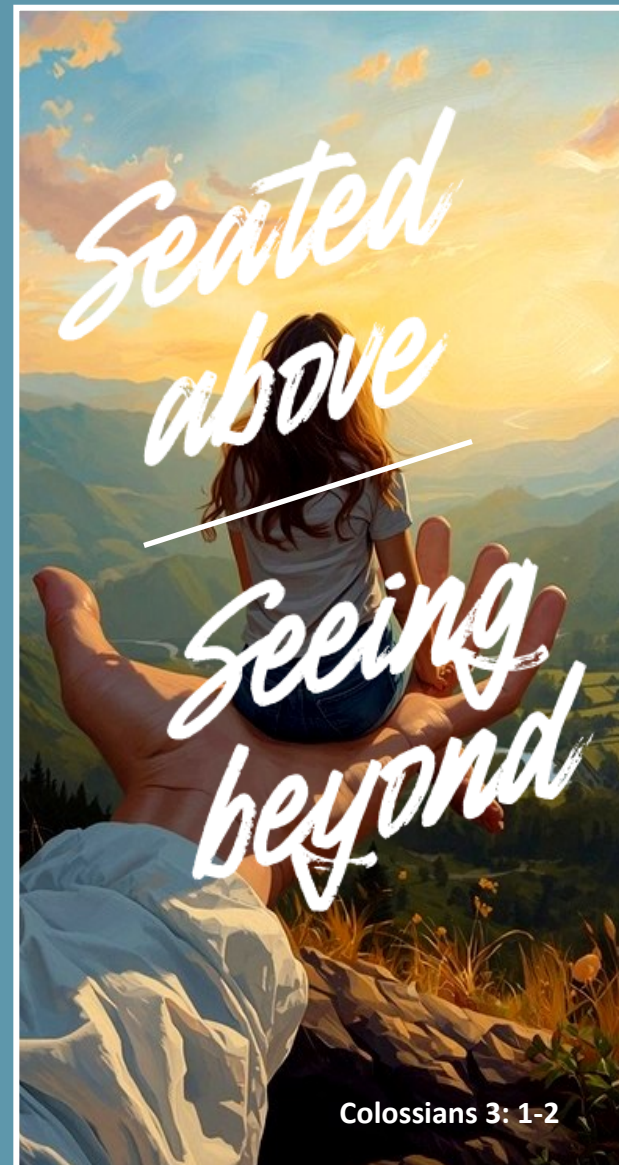

Bring your Bible as we will be 'marking them up' & Sketching over some of the pages. Also bring your coloured pencils and/or Bible markers



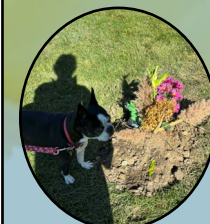
WORKSHOP: Cindy McKenna
